# Overall Summary of Findings

Demographic trends present in 2023-2024 KRA & 3GR:

- Females averaged sig. higher than Males
- Students of color averaged sig. lower than white students
- ECDIS students averaged sig. lower than non-ECDIS students

Differences between demographic comparisons

Gender < Minority < ECDIS</li>

Educational disparities begin early and show evidence of persisting due to unchanging systemic inequities affecting Summit County Youth

#### **KRA Overview**

KRA is required for all 1<sup>st</sup> time kindergartners attending public school

Must be administered no later than 20<sup>th</sup> day of instruction

Measures 4 early learning areas as well as an Overall score (OISR):

- Language and Literacy (LL)
- Mathematics (M)
- Physical Well-Being and Development (PD)
- Social Foundations (SF)

#### Scaled scores range from 202-298

The scales for the KRA domains are not equivalent; therefore, it would be inappropriate to compare the individual outcomes to one another







# KRA: Outcomes by Gender




## KRA: Outcomes by Race/Ethnic Group

#### **3GR Overview**

Ohio's 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Reading Guarantee is a program that identifies and provides support to students between Kindergarten and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade to reach proficiency by the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade

Students tested twice in the Fall and Spring

Scaled Score cut offs/categories:

- 545-671 ---> 'Limited'
- 672-699 ---> 'Basic'
- 700-724 ---> 'Proficient'
- 725-751 ---> 'Accelerated'
- 752-863 ---> 'Advanced'


SEI uses ODE's minimum 'passing' score range of 'Proficient' as the cut off category when reporting


ODE considers 'Basic' the cut off category for promotion to 4<sup>th</sup> grade

ODE considers 'Accelerated' the cut off category for being on track for college and career readiness








# 3GR: Outcomes by Gender




# 3GR: Outcomes by Race/Ethnic Group
